


# September 11

## Multifaith Peace Walk & Picnic

### Walk Guidelines

- Please be respectful and peaceful at all times.
- Get to know your fellow walkers.
- Allow others to pass on the sidewalk.
- Cross major streets at traffic lights only.
- Respect walk monitors and follow the rules of the road at all times.
- Please don't litter.
- Simple "Peace" signs are available. Other signs are discouraged.



If you are uncomfortable or concerned about someone's behavior or safety, speak to a walk organizer (look for the "Ask Me" tags) or walk monitor (look for the bright yellow vest). Remain calm and respectful. In an emergency, call 9-1-1.

### Shuttles after the walk

Free shuttles will leave from the Unitarian Universalist Church parking lot (505 E. Charleston Rd) at 5:00 pm, 5:20 pm, 5:35 pm, 5:55 pm, 6:10 pm and 6:25 pm. To get to the parking lot from the picnic, take the path out the back of Mitchell Park that goes through the Magical Bridge Playground toward E. Charleston Road, and turn right into the gate marked "Multifaith Peace Shuttle."

Water, refreshments, restrooms, and first aid kits are available at all stops along the walk.

Shalom, salaam -- Aleinu v'al kol ha'olam  
Shalom, salaam (repeat 2 lines)
